

CIMSPA – International Education partner requirements

Introduction

This position statement clarifies CIMSPA's position and its relationship with International Education partner. The Chartered Institute for the Management of Sport and Physical Activity (CIMSPA) is the professional development body for the UK's sport and physical activity sector, an employer led body supported and funded by Sport England and Sport Scotland.

Key asks of CIMSPA from the sectors employers are to,

- Standardise, endorse and quality assure education and training for anyone working in the Sport and Physical Activity sector.
- Provide a membership opportunity that clearly outlines a member's scope of practice.

In order for CIMSPA to effectively quality assure all its education partners that are applying to become a partner from overseas, all potential partners must meet and be able to evidence the below criteria.

- Must deliver to UK learners either face to face or through e-learning (CPD)
- The delivery of such courses needs to specifically align to UK laws, policies or guidelines, these may link to the following examples:
 - o Health and Safety
 - o EDI
 - o Safeguarding
 - o Data Protection
 - o CIMSPA endorsement policies, including relevant pre-requisites.
 - o CIMSPA partner code of conduct
 - o CIMSPA member code of conduct
 - o CIMSPA policies (e.g. delivering sport and physical activity online)
- Must map to a professional Standard where appropriate
- Provide evidence of any previous sanctions/complaint e.g. from regulators, awarding organisations etc

The above must be met in order to apply to become an educational partner with CIMSPA.
